"Noisy" history

We are ready to update you on the common fight against aircraft noise. Babites Parish Mayor, Andrejs Ence reported that this issue was discussed with the management of airlines. As a result, it was decided to establish a working group with the Civil Aviation Agency, which is administered by the Ministry of Posts Latvia, and it will continue to deal with these painful problems. The working group includes the chairman of Babites parish.

According to the initial control measurements, the noise level in Babites parish exceeds the allowable standard, but at the request of the airlines, additional measurements will be carried out.

"The main thing is that the mechanism has started, the responsible persons have begun to stir, and it moves", - said Andrejs Ence who promises to personally monitor the case and help to protect the rights of our residents.



In Saliena all is quiet

Recently, the head of the Riga Regional Police Department Ints Kuzis, has reported that "the crime rate in Riga has soared, more and more robberies and other crimes are being committed, the situation is dire"

Head of Saliena's Security Service, Pavel Nesterov, said that a growing number of vehicles are being stolen, according to him, the cars most in demand are Volkswagen, Audi, Porsche, BMW and Toyota.

Due to the fact that Saliena's security service are constantly patrolling Saliena and monitoring the situation, we are very happy to report that in the last 3 months there have been no major incidents.

Pavel Nesterov said "Personal safety is a collective phenomenon, only together can we deal with the increased crime rate". He asks you to inform the administration about suspicious people and objects within Saliena and, most importantly, please play an active role in the overall safety program".



Of course, the installation of a barrier on Mezaparks street and additional CCTV cameras on the main streets of Saliena will contribute to the safety of residents and their property. Video surveillance will be monitored and any non local cars on the territory will be carefully watched.

Also Pavel Nesterov advised to take as many precautions as possible, be sure to include an alarm in the house and for the car, at night, park your car in the garage or within your territory enclosed by a fence.
